Travel

Egypt is one of the most favoured travel destinations for German educational tourists. After a period of relative uncertainty for many travellers the confidence in the safety of the country has increased again and Egypt moves once more to the foreground as one of the most important travel destinations.

The Deutsch-Ägyptische Gesellschaft Köln e.V. has been able to organise several trips for members and interested persons: The first one in 1994 focused on the achievements of modern Egypt with visits to new research facilities and development projects, also to the vocational training centre which we support. The second trip brought us through the Sinai in 1995. The third one in 1997 was devoted entirely to the Islamic Cairo and the fourth one led us in 2000 to largely unknown and often neglected sites in the Delta with special focus on the most recent excavations. Further trips have led, amongst others, again to Cairo and Alexandria and Minya in Central Egypt and to the Oasis in the Western Deserts of Egypt. Travel beyond the usual touristic routes has been planned for the future.

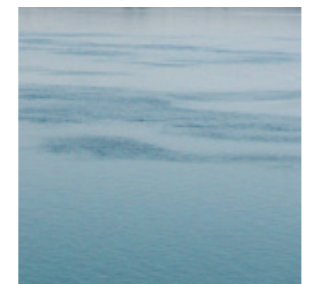

Purpose and Function of the Deutsch-Ägyptische Gesellschaft Köln e.V.

In order to deepen bilateral relations with Egypt there are regular informative and educational events as well as visits to museums here and abroad. Thus the rapidly changing realities in the fields of politics, culture and economics can be better understood.

These events include reports and presentations on Ancient Egypt

We have extensive contacts and relationships with numerous institutions and individuals in Egypt. Working with institutions such as "Bund Ägypter deutscher Bildung" (Federation of Egyptians with German Education) and the German Agency for international cooperation GIZ (former GTZ) is enabling the growth of these relationships.

This work is complimented by contributions from Egyptian artists and Arabic writers.

Sponsoring Education for Young Egyptians.

Besides all these activities, the Deutsch-Ägyptische Gesellschaft Köln runs a trans-confessional programme to sponsor Egyptian students between the ages 15 and 18 in vocational training centres. They are given the opportunity to learn a trade at a vocational training centre under a „Dual Educational System“ for a period of three years in total.

The sponsorship amounting to EUR 12.00 per month are paid directly and without deduction of administrative costs to the parents of students who are selected according to their needs and abilities.

The president of the "Bund Ägypter deutscher Bildung" in Cairo guarantees smooth disbursement of the scholarships.
